**When Jesus Steps Into Your Boat**

### **Life Group Questions • Text: Luke 5:1-11**

**1. Seeing Jesus Clearly**

In the sermon we saw that everything begins when we see Jesus for who He really is. What has most shaped your understanding of who Jesus is, and how has that changed the way you live?

**2. Seeing Ourselves Honestly**

Peter fell at Jesus' feet and confessed his sin. Why do you think encountering the holiness of Jesus makes us more aware of our own sin? What helps you stay humble and honest before God?

**3. Receiving Grace Personally**

Jesus told Peter, "Do not be afraid." When have you personally experienced God's grace in a moment when you expected guilt, shame, or rejection?

**4. Grace That Leads to Mission**

Jesus didn't just forgive Peter—He gave him a new purpose. How has following Jesus changed the direction or priorities of your life?

**5. Your Boat, Your Nets**

Peter's fishing boat became the place where Jesus revealed Himself and called him to mission. What areas of your everyday life (work, family, hobbies, relationships) might God want to use for His purposes? What would that look like?

**6. Living Sent**

The sermon emphasized that Christianity is not just about being forgiven but being sent. What does it look like practically for you to live as someone sent by Jesus? What is one thing you could put in motion immediately?

**7. Next Step of Obedience**

Peter responded to Jesus with obedience: "At your word I will..." What might God be asking you to trust Him with or obey Him in right now?
