

Float Team Member Procedures

Thank you so much for volunteering. The float team consists of many members that are already involved with other areas of VBS. So many of our jobs are just the beginning or the end or both. We will need to utilize you in between to help keep a better flow and consistency with the children. The games, crafts, café, teaching, and group leaders have volunteers who are required to always stay in their areas. Therefore, you will be asked to relieve them from time to time.

Arrival: When the kids arrive, you will be doing the job assignment you are assigned to. This may be drama, dance, or registration. Once those jobs are over, and any rehearsals for our drama/dance teams are over, you will become a floater. Some of the things you may be asked to do:

- Relieve people who need to use the facilities.
 - You must stay in the designated area of the person you are relieving until they return, this will usually only be a few minutes.
- Bring a child to the bathroom.
 - You should under no circumstances help a child inside the bathroom. Helping hand washing is recommended. If you take a child to the restroom, just stand outside the restroom door and wait for them in the hallway.
- Help in an area where another member was unable to attend.
- Bring around a snack tray to the different areas so those team members do not have to leave their areas.
- Serve water or coffee to different team areas.

Dismissal: A few minutes before the last session please return to your original assigned area.

If for any time during the hours of VBS you find yourself idle, please see a director so you can be assigned somewhere to help.
