

Games Team Procedures

Thank you so much for choosing to volunteer for our game team. Your job is going to be a fun one! As a front-line worker, working directly with children, it is necessary to ensure you are helpful, patient, and courteous. You will follow the procedures for the general team member guide. Game time is the perfect time to reinforce the teaching points for the day and be an extension of Christ's hands and his love. Smile and have fun with the kids while being a team player. Before during and after VBS Pray, Pray, Pray, with your teams and individually.

Games Leaders and Helpers:

Before VBS starts: Games team will meet weeks or months before the start of VBS to go over the games guide, help choose and plan the games for each day. The team will come up with a supply list for the directors.

Once Supplies are Acquired: Once supplies are acquired, the team will sort supplies for each day. Each day should be packed in a separate box, marked by the name of the game and day being used.

Start of VBS Week: keep in touch with each other. Please read and follow the general procedures. Every day, before the opening ceremony, prepare the game area with that day's game. If you want to see the opening ceremony, that is fine so long as once the opening is starting to finish, you head to your assigned area to be ready for your first group's arrival.

Arrival: HAVE FUN! Invite the children to listen to the rules and explain the game to them. In addition to your team, group leaders will also assist in keeping the children on task, many group leaders will not be able to physically participate but will help keep the children focused and in the game area.

There will be a security team out there watching for children going into unauthorized areas. However, please keep your eyes on the children also.

Dismissal: If you want to see the closing ceremony that is awesome, just remember to go back to your area and clean up for the day before leaving.
