

## Procedure - VBS Praise Team

Thank you so much for choosing to volunteer for the dance team. As a front-line worker, working directly with children, it is necessary to ensure you are helpful, patient, and courteous. You will follow the procedures for the general team member guide. Your job is going to be a fun one! Remember to be an extension of Christ's hands and his love. Smile and have fun with the kids while being a team player. Before during and after VBS Pray, Pray, Pray, with your teams and individually.

**Before VBS:** You will be given a sign language video and dance choreography. It is imperative that you study your choreography and sign language and learn them as soon as possible. You will be expected to be available for rehearsals the week prior to VBS. We will need the whole team to rehearse together for a more cohesive show.

**During VBS Week:** When the kids arrive, they are always excited. Dance is always one of the most exciting parts for the kiddos and they look up to the dancers, keep this in mind when around, or in earshot of the kids, they are watching everything you say and do.

- Your job will be the first and last 15 minutes or so of every day.
- Once your job is done, you can rehearse with the other dance team members in between opening and closing if need be.
- For 10 minutes during the games, we will be having the children learn the sign language song. Please make sure you are in the game area every session for the last 10 minutes.
- Between the opening and closing, aside from the last 10 minutes of games, you may be asked to do some floating jobs. Please read the Float Team guidelines as well.

If for any time during the hours of VBS you find yourself idle, please see a director so you can be assigned somewhere to help.
