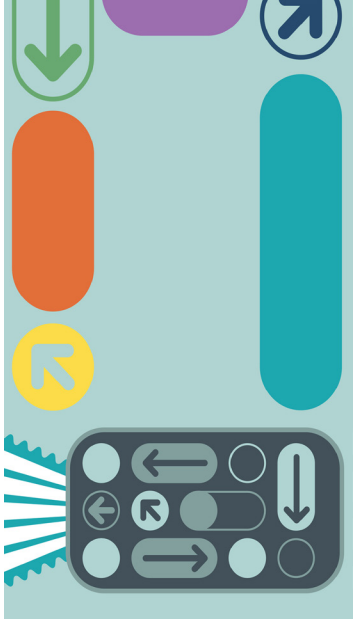
- The Large Group Slides Contact Sheet is provided for your reference, to be used as a comprehensive preview of this week's slides.

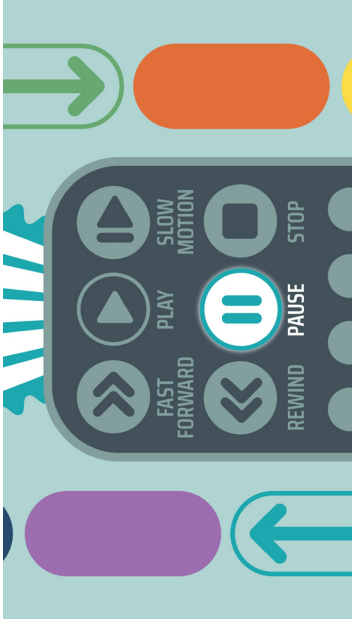

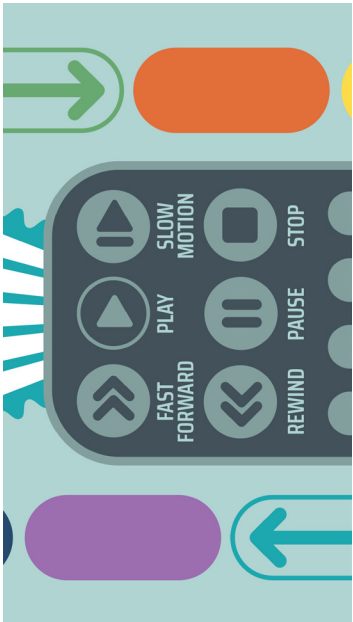
