A princess who competed in the Olympics. (There are quite a few real princesses who competed in the Olympics: Princess Anne, Queen Elizabeth's daughter; Princess Haya of Jordan; Princess Charlene of Monaco)

A princess whose name means "beautiful" in French. (Pretend: Belle from Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*)

A princess with fancy handwriting who wrote wedding invitations for other royalty. (Real: Duchess Meghan Markle)

A princess who has animals to help do housework. (Pretend: Snow White from Disney's *Snow White and the Seven Dwarves* and Cinderella from *Cinderella*)

A princess who is a health care worker. (Real: Princess Martha Louise of Norway is a physical therapist.)

A princess who worked as a waitress. (Pretend: Tiana from *The Princess and the Frog*; Real: Princess Mette-Marit of Norway)

A princess who rides horses. (Pretend: Merida from Disney's *Brave* and Belle from Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*; Real: Princess Haya of Jordan)

A princess with 70-foot-long hair. (Pretend: Rapunzel from Disney's *Tangled*)

A princess who is a rapper. (Real: Princess Sikhanyiso of Swaziland)
